

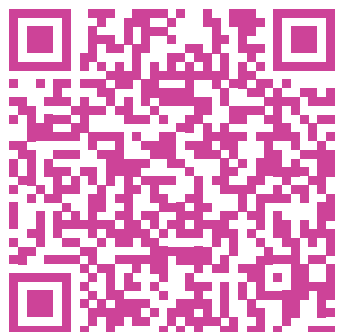
RELIGION IN LOS ANGELES:
